## Symptom

User did not succeed to migrate an Evdre report developed with BPC 7.5:

## Environment

SAP Business Planning and Consolidation (BPC) version 10 – SP4 for the Microsoft platform  
EPM Addin SP5

## Reproducing the Issue

1. Open the Evdre report developed in BPC 7.5.
2. Then, update the report to have the correct dimension selected.
3. Go EPM Ribon -> Tools->More->Evdre Migration.
4. The report is not migrated.

## Cause

In EPM add-in log, it is be stated that the EvDRE has been already migrated. An EvDRE report cannot be migrated in two steps (not supported by migration tool).

## Resolution

- User should start from the initial EvDRE report again.
- If he does not have anymore the original EvDRE workbook, he can try to copy/paste the entire range of cells of the EvDRE report (but do not copy/ paste the worksheet itself) in a new worksheet and he should be able to try the migration again from this new worksheet.
- After that, save the worksheet only after having checked that the migration was successful.
