Solution

For Business Planning and Consolidation on NetWeaver 730(Component CPMBPC 800), upgrade to support package SP11.

For Business Planning and Consolidation on NetWeaver 731 or 740(Component CPMBPC 801), upgrade to support package SP04.

Instructions of the new feature:

Property based Data Access Profile allows you to define an access on a set of Members filtered by Properties. The rules for data filtering are updated as below:

1. There are 5 levels of priority on DAP definition from higher to lower in case there are conflict definitions: Defined on Member, Defined on Properties, Inherited from parent Member, Inherited from ALL, Not defined(None access).
2. There is no impact on inheritance of the access if a Member in a Hierarchy is hit by Properties filter. In another word, the child Members of the Member would not inherit the access defined on their parent Member if the access is defined by Properties filter. But they would inherit the access from the grandparent Member.
